Thanks for taking time out of your busy schedule to attend the Prayer Summit. Your desire to pray more effectively is recognized by God because He said, *Ye shall seek me, and* find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart (Jeremiah 29:13).

Jesus central desire is that His Father's House be a house of prayer. The Lord Jesus said, *My house shall be called the house of prayer...* (Matthew 21:13). The true spirit of prayer does not consist in asking for blessings, but in receiving Him who is the giver of all blessings, and in living a life of fellowship with Him.—Sadhu Sundar Singh
