SPEAK APPROPRIATELY

Everybody longs for a nest without thorns.

Eph. 4:25 *Wherefore **putting away lying, speak every man truth** with his neighbor: for we are members one of another.*

Eph. 4:29 *Let no **corrupt communication** proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.*

Rules for Family Conversations

1. Think Twice Before You Speak
2. Speak Calmly, not Combatively
3. Compliment Instead of Criticize.
4. Magnify the Positives Instead of the Negatives
5. Listen First—Speak Later
6. Don't Interrupt—Learn to Interpret
7. Labor to be Understood and Labor to Understand
8. Honor God's Blueprint for the Home

3. GIVING THANKS IN ADVANCE

Believing you ACTUALLY possess what you ask for in prayer is not PRESUMPTION—The Bible calls it faith!

A HAPPY HOME IS WHERE FAMILY MEMEBERS

HAVE MASTERED THE ART OF FORGIVENESS

“Forgiveness is a beautiful concept until you have to forgive someone.”—C. S. Lewis

Eph. 4:31-32 *“Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice: And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, **forgiving one another**, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you.”*

FORGIVENESS IS NOT...

- Pretending no offense was committed
- Trying to figure out why the offender did what he/she did
- Blaming yourself for what your offender did to you
- Ignoring the pain in your heart

FORGIVENESS is...

- Appropriating the grace God has given to you and extending it to your offender
- Absorbing a liability someone else deserves to pay
- A decision which must be reaffirmed often
- Giving up my right to hurt you for hurting me
- The perfume the trampled flower leaves upon the heel that crushed it
- Cancellation of an offense
- Choosing to release a debt

It may cost you a lot to put things right, But it will cost you a lot more to leave it wrong!

Three Areas Where Forgiveness is Called for...

Here's how to get CLEAN...

- ADMIT it...
- QUIT it...
- FORGET it!

3. Praise Protocol

Ps. 100:4 *Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and **into his courts with praise**: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.*

“Instead of counting your BRUISES, try counting your BLESSINGS.”—Unknown

Praise God **WHEN** you feel like it...

Praise God **UNTIL** you feel like it!

4. Singing Protocol

Ps. 100:2 *Serve the LORD with gladness: **come before his presence with singing.***

Ps. 95:2 *Let us come before his presence with thanksgiving, and **make a joyful noise unto him with psalms.***

A HAPPY HOME IS WHERE FAMILY MEMBERS

PRAY TOGETHER

Eph. 6:18 *Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints*

Four Laws of Prayer Protocol in the Bible...

1. Gratitude Protocol

Ps. 100:4 *Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.*

Consider your PRESENT POSITION in light of your FORMER CONDITION.

“He who forgets the language of gratitude can never be on speaking terms with happiness.”—C. Neil Strait

2. Clean Protocol

Ps. 24:3-4 *Who shall ascend into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place? **He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart;** who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully.*

He bore our **sin** that we might have His **righteousness**.

- Took our **guilt** that we might have His **grace**.
- Took our **shame** that we might have His **smile**.
- Took our **punishment** that we might have His **peace**.
- Took our **death** that we might have His **life**.
- Took our **penalty** that we might have His **pardon**.

1. Accepting Forgiveness FROM God

Ps. 130:4 *“There is forgiveness with thee, that thou mayest be feared”*

Acts 13:38 *“Through this man (Jesus) is preached unto you the **forgiveness of sins**”*

Eph. 1:7 *“In whom we have redemption through his blood, the **forgiveness of sins**, according to the riches of his grace”*

2. Granting Forgiveness TO Others

Our forgiveness of others is based on what God has done FOR us, not what others have done TO us.

Forgiveness is NOT an Emotion—It is a DECISION.

Forgiveness is a DECISION to Cancel a Debt.

Once you Release a debt DON'T...

- REHEARSE it...
- NURSE it...
- CURSE it...
- DO pray for them.

3. Asking Forgiveness FROM Others

“Never ruin an apology with an excuse.”—Ben Franklin

Ten Words for Revival in the Home...

→ “I was wrong. I am sorry. Will you forgive me?”

Family Huddle Time:

1. Discussion: What spoke to you in this message?
2. Do you need to use those Ten Words for Revival in the Home? “I was wrong. I am sorry. Will you forgive me?”
3. Pray Together.

A HAPPY HOME IS WHERE FAMILY MEMBERS

RECONCILE QUICKLY

Before marriage opposites ATTRACT. After marriage opposites IRRITATE!

Eph. 4:26 *Be ye angry, and sin not: let not the sun go down upon your wrath*

Eight Guidelines for Resolving Conflicts:

1. Be honest.

v. 25 *Wherefore putting away lying, speak every man truth with his neighbour: for we are members one of another.*

2. Learn to control your anger

v. 26—*Be ye angry and sin not.*

3. Determine the right time to deal with problems.

v. 26—*Don't let the sun go down upon your wrath*

4. Be committed to a creative alternative.

v. 28—*Let him that stole steal no more, but rather let him labor working that which is good.*

5. Be tactful

v. 29—*Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth.*

6. Stop Grieving Holy Spirit

v. 30—*And grieve not the holy Spirit of God...*

7. Keep it private

v.31—*Let all bitterness, wrath, evil speaking . . . be put away from you, with all malice.*

8. Restore your relationships

v. 32—*Be kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another.*

Conflicts are inevitable.

Conflicts are solvable.
